OLD BUSINESS: It was asked what the requirements were to take a meeting into the jail?? Answer given was; One year sobriety, off paper and complete the Butler jail orientation class. The reason for that question;

Someone had wanted to go into the jail meeting while on the Vivitrol shot. The AA jail committee declined this person to go in.

Long discussion, debate and arguments took place of this topic.

Someone stated, AA cannot be diluted. Someone else started, we stress in AA that abstinence is necessary. Jail coordinator was voted in by the district, the coordinator and the committee was made, they make the guidelines. And of course the Butler jail has their requirements also.

Dcm stated: "The district officer panel, does not have an opinion on this issue."

AA has had traditions since : First published in the **April 1946** AA Grapevine under the title; Twelve Points to Assure Our Future and were formally adopted at AA's First International Convention in **1950**. Wilson's book on the subject, Twelve Steps and Twelve Traditions, was published in April, **1953**.

One – Our common welfare should come first; personal recovery depends upon A.A. unity.

Two – For our group purpose there is but one ultimate authority – a loving God as He may express Himself in our group conscience. Our leaders are but trusted servants, they do not govern.

Three – The only requirement for A.A. membership is a desire to stop drinking.

Four – Each group should be autonomous except in matters affecting other groups, or A.A. as a whole.

Five – Each group has but one primary purpose – to carry its message to the alcoholic who still suffers.

Six – An A.A. group ought never endorse, finance or lend the A.A. name to any related facility or outside enterprise, lest problems of money, property and prestige divert us from our primary purpose.

Seven – Every A.A. group ought to be fully self-supporting, declining outside contributions.

Eight – Alcoholics Anonymous should remain forever nonprofessional, but our service centers may employ special workers.

Nine – A.A., as such, ought never be organized, but we may create service boards or committees directly responsible to those they serve.

Ten – Alcoholics Anonymous has no opinion on outside issues, hence the A.A. name ought never be drawn into public controversy.

Eleven – Our public relations policy is based upon attraction rather than promotion; we need always maintain personal anonymity at the level of press, radio and films.

Twelve – Anonymity is the spiritual foundation of all our Traditions, ever reminding us to place principles before personalities.

It was asked, how to become a group?? Answered; Have AA meetings for 6 months, apply at GSO for a meeting number , get listed in the meeting list.

Let it sink in, will be a new meeting working on getting there GSO number.
